I am sure you have had the information about the Bart's Bash event from your class captains but here is some additional information.

The Aim

The Andrew Simpson Foundation is attempting to break the Guinness World Record by having **"The Largest Sailing Race in 24 Hours (Multiple Venues)" Guinness World Record attempt**

Registration

To take part and be included in the record attempt at Medway Yacht Club you will need to sign up to race at <http://www.bartsbash.co.uk> and follow the 'sign me up' link and create an 'account' (not a financial account unless you want to follow the Just Giving link to fundraise). If you do not sign up you can still take part in [the race so register on the Sunday morning](#). **We need 25 boats minimum!**

Registration on the day is 0800hrs and 0930 for group 1 and 0800hrs to 1000hrs for group 2 on the morning of the 21st September in the library.

We are asking a minimum contribution of £5 per boat/person which we will collect from you at registration, **all** of which will go to the Andrew Simpson Sailing Foundation.

It is the intention to sail the **Magula Trophy** on the 21st but this is to be confirmed.

Pirates Cave have donated a **prize** to the first boat in each group over the finish line. So many thanks to them for their kind donations.
