

## How to use Sailwave

First of all you must have the latest version of Sailwave on your PC. IT will only run on a Windows PC so if you are an Apple person, unless you can run a Windows emulator you are out of luck. It will also not run on I-pads or Android tablets.


You will get the normal Windows Question asking if you want Sailwave to change your system. Say “yes” and the installation Wizard will start










Select "Finish". Sailwave is now installed. Now the fun can start.

You should have a new program section in your start menu called "Sailwave"




When you open it you will have a new program “Sailwave” Select it and you new toy should be ready to play




In this example we are going to set up A 6 race Spring Series for the Squib Fleet.


If you select “Edit next” it will automatically move on to the next race rather than having to select it.

That’s your series set up. Simple really

Remember to save the file or you will be very annoyed.

You are now ready to start recording the race results.

To do this use the “Sail Number Wizard” which is very easy to use with one design racing.



Press the “Sail Num Wizard” button as shown above and the wizard should open

To publish the results to the Sailwave web site set the screen up as the example above. It is important that the file name has the "Medway/" prefix as shown above. This will put the results into our folder. Make sure the file name reflects the race you are reporting on. The file name will default to the previous one used so take care here.




Sometimes, and for no known reason you may fail to upload the results to the Sailwave website. This may be due to a Setup change being required.

This is fairly simple to do so when you open Sailwave follow the process shown below to amend the setting and then try the upload again.


Open Sailwave and one of the top menu items is "Setup". When you select this the first entry in the drop down list is "Global Options".




When you open the Global Options you should see the following screen



From the tabs along the top select “FTP” and you should see the following screen.



If the box marked “Use Passive Transfers – leave unchecked if you are not sure” is unchecked (as in the example above) then check it




The screen should look like the example above. Press the “OK” button. This should return you to the main sailwave screen.

Try the publish to Sailwave again.




