

# Schedule of Races



## Medway Regatta 2022

The Race Committee expects to start classes at **five-minute intervals**.

The first warning signal will not be before 09:55 all boats are asked to be within sight of the Committee Boat by this time.

Please pay close attention to signals made by the Committee Boat.

Courses and the order of racing will be announced to competitors via VHF channel 72

Class	Flag
<b>Class One</b> NHC 0.889 and above and IRC*	"1" 
<b>Class Two</b> NHC 0.888 and below and IRC*	"2" 
<b>Class Three</b> Open Class -Helms and crew who don't race regularly	"3" 
<b>Dragon</b> One design	"D" 
<b>Sonata</b> One design	"F" 
<b>Squib</b> One Design	"NN 9" 

If 2 or more races are scheduled for a class the second race will start ASAP after the first race has finished and any subsequent races will start ASAP after the previous race finishes. Competitors should stay within reasonable distance of the Committee Boat

\*The rating bands for cruiser classes are provisional and will depend on entries.  
Final rating bands should be on the website by 1<sup>st</sup> June 2022.

Cruiser Classes one, two and three are scheduled to complete a maximum of 3 races, either the Thursday or the Friday races maybe one long race or two short races depending on the weather.

Dragon class is scheduled to complete a maximum of eight races. Four windward/Leeward races on Thursday and Friday. This may be altered at the discretion of the Race Committee depending on the weather.

Sonata class is scheduled to complete a maximum of eight races. One day of windward/leeward racing and one day of either a long race or two short races. This may be altered at the discretion of the Race Committee depending on the weather.

Squib class is scheduled to complete a maximum of four races. Two races per day. This may be altered at the discretion of the Race Committee depending on the weather
