- h) Yellow Hoist
- i) Changing Rooms
- j) Showers

11.3 – Access to Training

- k) Subsidised RYA courses
- l) Adult Saturday Training Sessions – minimum age 19 years
- m) Sunday Youth Training sessions – only if aged 8 or above on date of session, maximum age 18 years.
- n) 1:1 tuition and other specific training events – only aged 6 or above on the date of the session/event.
- o) Other Specific Training events, subject to published/relevant age restrictions.
- p) Access to Club Training Sail Boats, under the supervision of Chief Instructor (not for general hire / private use)
- q) Class / Group Training

Notes

- i. If under the age of 14 years, only during organised Young Persons sailing, 1:1 tuition or specific event.
- ii. So long as a parent/guardian is on club premises for the duration of the training and who agrees to provide reasonable assistance in training sessions.
- iii. Only whilst supervising a Young Person.

Appendix 2 – Eligibility Criteria for Election or Admission to Membership

Category	Eligibility Criteria
Single	Aged 26 or over at the date of election or 1 st January, whichever is later.
Family	Aged 18 over at the date of election or 1 st January, whichever is later. Lead applicant and their partner permanently living together at the same address together with their children under the age of 18 or 25 if in fulltime education. Grandchildren at the discretion of the Management Committee.
Young Person	Aged between 6 and 18 at the date of election or January 1st whichever is the later who must, if under 18 be supervised by a member in the Club House or between the ages of 19 and 25 inclusive and in full time education at the date of election or January 1 st .
Young Adult (19-25yrs)	Aged between 19 and 25 at the date of election or January 1st whichever is the later
Young Adult (26-30yrs)	Aged between 26 and 30 at the date of election or January 1st whichever is the later
Veteran Including Family Veteran	Closed to new applications irrelevant of qualifying. Aged 60 or over on January 1st who have been Full members of the Club for not less than 15 years and were elected prior to 1st January 1990
Loyalty	Aged 70 years and over with 25 years consecutive years' Full membership.
Life	Persons who have paid a single Life Membership fee
Out of Port	Available to members who have previously held 5 years continuous Full Membership. This membership allows for no more than six visits in one calendar year and is a limited non-voting membership. At the discretion of the Management Committee. Such members are ineligible for Veteran membership.
Honorary	At the invitation of the Management Committee
Group/Young Group/Student/Corporate/Associate/Temporary	Admitted by Management Committee under rule 4.4.8. and in the case of Temporary members subject to discretion of the Management Committee including but not limited to members of RYA affiliated or other clubs or persons participating in any 'open event' hosted by the Club.
Guardian	Has signed an undertaking to attend with and supervise a Young Person member at all times whilst on Club premises and engaged in the Young Persons sailing activities and agrees to provide reasonable assistance with Young Person sailing activities as requested by instructors.
Fitting Out	Aged over 18, wishing to bring a craft ashore for a period not exceeding four weeks for the purposes of fitting out, maintenance and repair at a time convenient to the Club.
