

# Medway Yacht Club training & course terms & conditions



Medway Yacht Club also known as MYC

1. In the case of unfavourable weather conditions on the day of training, classroom-based learning may be offered. In this instance no credit or refund will be due.
2. Participants must pay for courses at the time of booking. If the participant wishes to cancel, they must do so giving not less than 7 days' notice, in this event a full refund or credit will be made. If the incorrect notice is given, MYC will retain 10% of the full cost.
3. Medway Yacht Club (MYC) always reserves the right to cancel the training/course at any time giving 24 hours' notice. Depending on reason for cancellation, the MYC may credit to another course/training session or offer a full refund to participants.
4. All participants must wear a personal flotation device whilst afloat.
5. Buoyancy aids used should comply with EN 393/ISO 12402-5 (50 Newton/Level 50) or USCG Type III PFD standards. Crotch straps should be used if fitted. Lifejackets should be MCA or MED approved ("Wheelmarked") or comply with BS EN 396, BS EN 399 standards or their successors ISO 12402-2, 3 or 6. Adults lifejackets should be a minimum of 150N and be fitted with a crotch-strap, whistle, retro-reflective materials. MYC has a limited supply of aids, please let us know before the course/training starts to let us know if you need to borrow one.
6. MYC does not take any responsibility for any personal/hired items brought to the club for any training or course by any participant.
7. All children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult for the duration of training or courses and this person must be 18 years or older.
8. MYC, nor any of its agents or employees shall be liable in any way whatsoever in respect of loss or damage to property whilst leading/assisting a training or course, unless the damage is wilfully caused.
9. All bookings are accepted on the understanding that bookings made by a club member for the safety of participants must be observed. Users are asked to respect all the equipment that is provided and anyone who causes wilful damage will be required to pay or replace damaged equipment.
10. Participants with a medical condition must notify the office when booking. This information is kept confidential.
11. The MYC Instructor reserves the right to end the training session with immediate effect should the participant compromise safety, or the aims of the course, through inappropriate behaviour.
12. Having received these terms and conditions, you hereby acknowledge that you have read and fully understood the above conditions of participation.
13. DATA PROTECTION The information given by you on this form will be used by us to keep a record of all training completed at MYC.
14. PHOTOGRAPHY We may take photographs and video footage of training for use by us in connection with the promotion of us and our activities.
