NOTICE OF RACE

The organising authority is Medway Yacht Club.

1. RULES.

1.1 The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 The prescriptions of the RYA will apply. Reference is made to; [RYA Prescriptions 2021 - 2024](#)

1.3 The directives of the Peel Ports Medway (PPM) and the London Port Authority (LPA), the MYC Cruiser Class Minimum Equipment List (MEL) 2022, the rating rules and the Sailing Instructions will apply.

1.4 The National Handicap for Cruisers (NHC), as amended by MYC, will be applied to all races and all entrants who do not have a current 2022 IRC Certificate. RYA NHC Base number shall be applied but may be changed at the discretion of the Race Officer, if an alternative NHC rating is available using the RYA NHC Rating Calculator. An adjustment in handicap will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.

1.5 IRC Boats must provide a valid 2022 IRC Certificate prior to the boats first race. An IRC entrant cannot be dual scored under NHC.

1.6 White sail entry must be declared upon the entry sheet with boat name and the type and model details.

1.7 Racing rule 64.1 will be changed as follows:

1. RRS 64.1 Protest Committee penalties and exonerations; The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

The exoneration penalty and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration procedures of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedure will be available. Decisions from RYA Arbitration may be referred to a protest committee but cannot be reopened or appealed.

2 ADVERTISING.

2.1 Boats may be required to display sponsorship advertising in the form of a pennant attached to the backstay, as required within the Sailing Instructions.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY.

3.1 The racing is open to all MYC members and non-members as bona fide guests of the club.

3.2 The Race committee reserves the right to refuse an entry.

3.3 Eligible boats may only enter races after their owner or owner's representative has registered them by completing a race declaration form and delivered it to the MYC office or

the Race Officer. Race declaration forms are available from the MYC office and MYC website.

3.4 For the 2022 Autumn Series there will be no entry Fee to boost entries. If an entry Fee has been pre-paid for the Autumn Series, the fee shall be re-paid provided a payment record can be produced.

3.5 Class Divisions as follows:

Class 1: IRC Entry Boats

Class 2: NHC Entrants (Spinnaker)

Class 3: NHC Entrants (White Sail – No Spinnaker)

NB. Depending upon entries received for any individual race or series of races, the organising authority may adjust the class divisions and/or introduce a further class. Any such adjustments will be published to competing boats at least twenty-four hours before the first scheduled warning signal of the race or the first race in the series on the MYC website and displayed on the Sailing Committee official noticeboard. An adjustment in the class divisions and/or an introduction of further classes will not be grounds for redress.

3.6 Entries shall be submitted 48 hours prior to a published race, although a late entrant after the closing deadline may announce their intention to race via VHF, stating sail number and NHC/IRC handicap, up to the warning signal of the first class start but at the *sole discretion* of the Race Officer and provided a Race Declaration Form has been submitted to the MYC Club Office.

4 Data Protection

4.1 By entering the competitors agree to provide limited personal data to the Organising Authority. The Organising Authority will process your personal data for the purpose of administering the event but will not transfer any information to any third party other than to publish the entry list and Race Results.

5 CLASSIFICATION.

Not applicable.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES AND FEES.

6.1 This Notice of Race applies to the MYC Autumn Series 2022. Races will be held at the dates and times published in the attached Cruiser Class NOR Schedule 2022.

6.2 Race Entry Fees for the MYC Autumn Series 2022 shall be £nil. Refer to Autumn Series 2022 Entry Form.

7 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES.

Not applicable.

8 SCHEDULE.

- 8.1** Please refer to the "Schedule to the Notice of Race" for dates and starting times of the MYC Cruiser Race Program.

9 MEASUREMENT.

- 9.1** Where a boat entered for NHC is not listed in the RYA online Base List, the Cruiser Class Committee shall have discretionary powers to nominate a provisional club NHC rating. A yacht owner has no redress following the race results being published.
- 9.2** A yacht owner may make an approach to the RYA (NHC Technical Representative) for further clarification of a yacht's correct NHC Base handicap. The Cruiser Class Committee shall use the RYA amended rating provided it is received in writing from the RYA NHC Technical Representative for future events.
- 9.3** Where a boat wishes to be scored under IRC, a current 2022 IRC certificate shall be provided upon entry.
- 9.4** Boats shall race in rating trim and be available for inspection on the day of the entered race.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

- 10.1** The sailing instructions will be available on the MYC website and displayed on the Sailing Committee official noticeboard located in the entrance to the Clubhouse 48 hours before Race 1 of the Autumn Series 2022.

11 VENUE.

- 11.1** Racing shall take place in the River Medway, Thames Estuary.

12 THE COURSES.

- 12.1** The courses to be sailed will use navigation buoys and/or special marks. The Medway Cruiser Class Course Sheet 2022 will be available on the MYC website, at the MYC office and in the Race Hut.

13 PENALTY SYSTEM.

- 13.1** The standard RRS 2021-2024 shall apply to all races, excluding where a boat is being raced Single or Double Handed; in such cases RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. This change only applies to boats being raced Single or Double Handed and is made upon safety grounds.

14 SCORING.

- 14.1** Where races are defined as a Series in the attached Cruiser Class NoR Schedule, the Low Point System of Appendix A RRS 2021 - 2024 will be used.
- 14.2** Refer to Cruiser Class NoR Schedule for confirmation of number of races to constitute a series and applicable discards.
- 14.3** All entrants in Classes 2 & 3 including NHC Base Handicaps arising from sections 9.1 or 9.2, will be used throughout the Autumn Series 2022 event. The event will be scored using a **fixed NHC Base Handicap, with no adjustment from Race to Race**. NHC race amended handicaps from previous events will not be used for the Autumn Series 2022 event. The NHC system is therefore modified locally by MYC and there shall be no-redress against the Race Committee's decision.

15 SUPPORT BOATS

17 HAUL OUT RESTRICTIONS.

There are no haul out restrictions.

18 DIVING EQUIPMENT / PLASTIC POOLS.

19 RADIO COMMUNICATION.

MYC Cruiser Class Minimum Equipment List (MEL) 2022 stipulates that all boats carry an operational VHF and the Race committee may broadcast course information by VHF. Where racing is conducted from the Club Line, communication will be on VHF Channel M/37 with the call sign "Upnor Line". Where racing is conducted by a committee boat, communication will be on Channel 72 with call sign "Offshore One".

20 PRIZES.

Prizes for each race or series of races will be shown in the attached MYC Autumn Series NoR Schedule 2022 (Amended).

21 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY.

Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event.
- b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore.
- c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions.
- d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate; (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities.
- e) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- f) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.
- g) It is their responsibility to carry out a CoronaVirus risk assessment and to ensure that they race within all legal restrictions and Government and RYA recommendations to ensure Covid-19 safety

22 INSURANCE.

- 22.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,500,000 per incident or the equivalent.
